ENVIRONMENTAL OBJECTIVES

WASTE MANAGEMENT: The Company will...

Ensure regular documented assessment of waste products to identify areas where recycling or waste minimisation can be carried out.

Comply with all appropriate environmental legislation concerning waste management and ensure that all necessary documentation is maintained in accordance with the Control of Pollution Act 1974.

CoSHH: The Company will at all times...

Comply with the 2002 Control of Substances Harmful to Health (CoSHH) Regulations.

Administer the Regulations, complete and review Risk Assessments and control the use of potentially hazardous substances through advice from the Health & Safety Manager and the HSE.

NOISE: The Company will...

Seek to meet the Noise at Work Regulations 2005 and adhere to the requirements set by HSE and the Local Planning Authority under the Control of Pollution Act 1974.

Protect its employees and the environment from damaging noise exposure as laid down by the Noise at Work Regulations 2005

Undertake Health Surveillance in the form of hearing tests to ensure the health and wellbeing of all employees.

Undertake regular Noise Monitoring at key areas around the site to ensure operations are being carried out within the limits set by the Local Planning Authority.

Undertake personal Noise Monitoring on all employees to identify areas of risk.
