

**DUST: The Company will...**

Plan and execute work so as to minimise the levels of dust arising from site operations.

Ensure that all employees are provided with suitable respiratory protective equipment and be fully trained in its use.

Ensure that all measures are taken to minimise the pollution of the environment in compliance with appropriate regulations and limits set by the Local Planning Authority.

Undertake Health Surveillance in the form of lung function tests to ensure the health and wellbeing of all employees.

Undertake regular Dust Monitoring at key areas around the site to ensure operations are being carried out within the limits set by the Local Planning Authority.

Undertake personal Dust Monitoring on all employees to identify areas of risk.

**WATER COURSES: The Company will...**

Comply with all requirements set out by the Environment Agency in relation to operating a business close of a natural or managed water course.


Taking precautions through safe systems of work to avoid accidental or malicious spillage of substances which could prove harmful to the water course or the environment surrounding it.

**TRAINING: The Company will...**

Provide appropriate Health & Safety and Environmental Risk training and ensure that information on relevant matters is made available to all employees, contractors and visitors.

Encourage identification and reporting by training all employees to recognise signs of possible environmental impact.

Encourage a culture of continuous improvement in areas where there are risks to Health & Safety or the Environment.
